# PROPRIETIES AND PROCEDURES

## PROPRIETIES

1. Bids should be written in a uniform manner, without emphasis and without undue haste or hesitation.
2. Players should maintain a courteous attitude towards partner and opponents at all times. They **should not** show any sign of approval or disapproval of a call or play; look intently at any other player during the auction or play; detach a card from their hand before it is their turn to play or lead; mix their cards before the result of the deal has been agreed.
3. **Players' responsibilities at the table:**
  - North:** Ensures that the correct board is being played and that the board and bidding pad are correctly positioned. **The board must remain in the centre of the table at all times until play is completed.**
  - South:** Before play, check that you have the correct EW pair and board/s at your table, as shown on the Bridgemate screen. After the board has been played and the result agreed, enter the score details into the Bridgemate. Pass the Bridgemate to East to check and verify.
  - East:** Check the details and if correct press the accept button.
  - West:** Move the boards to North at the next table after the move has been called.
  - NB: The contract details may be entered by dummy to avoid delay.**
4. It is improper to convey information to partner by means of a call or play based on a special partnership understanding, unless the information is freely available to the opponents.
5. The Director must be called when any irregularity occurs. Failure to call the Director may mean that players forfeit their rights.
6. All psyche calls must be **notified by the psyche caller** to the Director immediately at the end of the session.

## PROCEDURES

- A **Members are required to be seated 10 minutes** prior to start times for all sessions. **The Director may exclude late arrivals from play.**
- B On Teams nights Captains should have their team seated by 7.05pm and collect the table fees from **their** team.
- C Members are reminded that cards are a costly item. Please box carefully & refrain from eating while handling the cards.

**Remember that the building and all the furnishings belong to you and all other members of the Club, so please treat your assets with care.**

# RULES FOR CLUB MATCHES 2026

- DIVISIONS:** Each member of the Club has been allocated a grade.  
Silver Division plays on Monday evenings and the occasional Wednesday evening if required. Silver Reserve Division plays on Tuesday evenings. Wednesday afternoon, Thursday, Open nights and Friday are open sessions, and any member may play with any other member.
- THURSDAY EVENINGS: New Year Pairs:** basic bridge rules apply - standard Stayman, standard ace ask & transfers only.  
**Mixed Pairs and Christmas Pairs:** members must play with partners from a division other than their own - Junior tournament rules apply. A Reserve player may play with a novice if there is no Silver player available. 9 nights to qualify for Mixed Pairs. **Winners:** The pair with the best average percentage on handicap.
- PAIRS FORMAT:** (New format applies to both Silver & Silver Reserve divisions)  
**Qualifying Round:** The first **seven** nights for 2026. To qualify a pair must play any **four** of these **seven** nights. The top 14 pairs will qualify for the Pairs Championship. Positions will be the best 14 average percentages with all nights played, being used for calculations. The remaining pairs will play in the Plate section for the remainder of the year. Pairs who do not play a minimum of 4 of these 7 nights will be placed in the Plate section.  
There will be NO carryover between qualification and the main competitions. Following qualification there will be 11 nights left beginning Monday March 9 for Silver & Tuesday March 10 for Silver Reserve. The winners will be the Pair with the highest average percentage & must play a minimum of 8 of these nights. All of these nights will be played using Howell movements so that all Pairs will play each other regularly. All nights played will be used for calculations.  
Once the two sections are formed a player in the championship will **NOT** be available to play as a substitute in the plate section. There will be **NO** change for Wednesday Pairs for 2026.
- SERIES:** Pairs must play on **all** nights listed to qualify. A substitute for one or other of a pair is permitted on only **one** occasion in any one competition. A pair may qualify to win **one** series only.  
The Pam Bower Swiss Pairs is not included for promotion purposes.  
The 1st and 2nd placed players in a Silver Reserve series may play in a subsequent series in Silver.  
**a) Series Trophy:** To qualify any pair may play together in only **one** series and one other session with the same partner. Players must play a minimum of 70% of all qualifying nights.  
**The Whitcombe & Tombs and Doris Hanan Trophy series are not included.**

**b) President's Trophy:** To qualify any pair may play together in Pairs, only **one** series and **one** other session with the same partner. Players must play a minimum of 70% of all qualifying nights. Pairs qualifying series not included. **The Whitcombe & Tombs and Doris Hanan Trophy series are not included.** The winner/s of these two trophies will be the player/s with the highest average %.

5. **FOUR NIGHT TROPHY MATCHES:** Both of these matches are four night handicap series. To qualify players can only play with players not previously played with or intend to play with in the current year. All sessions must be played. Ultimate winners in each Trophy match will be the players with the best average percentage over the four nights.
6. **SUBSTITUTES:** No player may substitute for a player in a **lower** division or grade.
7. **TEAMS:** Teams of four will be played on Thursday evenings. The number of nights will depend on entries and format required. No defaults will be allowed, but if the situation arises the Match Committee will decide on penalties and adjusted scores. In the event of a tie, the tie breaking procedure to be followed shall be as set out in the NZ Bridge Manual, appropriate to the competition format. The Match Committee will decide on the type of competition and other relevant matters including handicaps. All matches must be played at the club on the correct night except in exceptional circumstances. Substitutes may only be obtained from Invercargill Bridge Club members. A player originally entered as a member of a team may not subsequently play as a substitute for another team. Silver players **cannot** substitute in Reserve or Junior Teams. Reserve players **cannot** substitute in Junior teams.
8. **MIXED TEAMS:** Players select their own teams. The team may contain no more than two Silver players and preferably include at least one player who has not more than three full years of playing experience. A list of eligible junior players will be posted on the noticeboard.  
All team members, including substitutes, will be individually handicapped.

# Duty Members' Tasks

## Before Bridge

- Set up tea, coffee, milo, sugar, biscuits, & milk. Top up from storeroom if necessary.
- Check that baskets are complete. Each basket should contain pencils or pens, a pencil sharpener, a bidding pad, a Bridgmate & solid boards. Supplies are in the west room cupboard.
- Collect the table fees, **count and receipt money**: bags for money are in the west room cupboard.
- **Place money in bar slot, ask if you are unsure, please don't leave the money in the playing room.**
- **Half fill the basin in the kitchen sink with hot soapy water.**

## At the end of the session

- Tidy the refreshment area and wipe the tray and benches.
- Wash and dry the cups, teaspoons and milk jug.
- Straighten chairs.
- Tidy baskets and pick up any rubbish.
- Collect used glasses and ask bar person to open the bar if necessary.
- Collect table numbers (in order) and place beside the computer.
- Place boards numerically in boxes and return to the Secretary's office.
- If the wheelchair or walker have been used return to the plant room
- **Pull back drapes (the alarms don't work if the drapes are closed).**

Please ask a committee member if you are unsure of anything.

**If you are not going to be at bridge, please arrange for someone else to swap with you.**
