Avenal Park Swiss Pairs

Tournament: Arrangements in hand.
Director confirmed – Craig Rodgers (Jane C will bring Craig's lunch)

Prizes to be \$60, \$50, \$30 (dependent on sections/numbers).
Judith is to follow-up with the sponsor.

Masonic Lodge Tournament:

Director – Moss to be asked; in the event he is unavailable, Marilyn to be asked. Match Committee meeting to be held prior to this tournament, so nothing further at this time.

Online Teams (NZ Bridge):

Recommendation from the Committee is not to promote this, given it is competing with our own Club night competitions. Judith undertook to follow-up and see if they could be run on another night.

Whitcombe & Tombs and Doris Hannan Series:

Complaints via word of mouth have been received about the proposed format. Noted irrespective of the time of year, the series has not been well supported.

Recommendation: This year the competition format provide for players to play with four different partners for the series, but there is to be no restrictions on whether they have played with that partner before. To remain a handicapped series, as we are encouraging Silver Reserve players to play up.

Directors: Not many qualified directors, and use of non-qualified directions on tournaments discussed. Agreed we need to encourage those who are Directing to sit the exam. Greg is interested. Urge people to take advantage of the information/support/training available via NZ Bridge.

Formal Complaint re Player:

The complaint laid by a Director about a Silver Reserve player's behaviour on a recent Tuesday night was read to the meeting. Noted that Tony Winters as President had spoken to the person concerned directly about this at the first opportunity, and directed that they apologise to the Director. The club is aware that, to date, that apology has not been received, but the behaviour has improved. This matter to be referred to the Recorder (Tony Winter will do). Pattern of behaviour is concerning, and to be watched.

Non-playing Scorers for 10A and Above:

Noted the requirement of NZ Bridge is that a non-playing Scorer is required to be provided for these tournaments. We did not do that last time – scoring was shared. Not sure what the concerns are around this. Would limit our table numbers if our scorers cannot play. Judith to follow-up with NZ Bridge.

TWIG: Gore club is hosting this year. Geoff Eyles to follow-up with information to support them.

Murihiku Tournament:

S Strang to be approached re availability to be the Director for this tournament.

Silver Reserve Handicaps:

Recommendation:

Those who have qualified for promotion, and declined promotion, are not to be eligible to win any series or trophies, as they are considered to be Silver players playing in Silver Reserve. Handicaps will continue to apply for two years. Those previously handicapped last year will continue to be handicapped this year.

Silver Reserve Blockage:

To be discussed in full at April meeting dedicated to this situation.

Eunice Hewton Cup could be utilised as possible separate competition in this grade. Split off the division? Is it big enough? Further options considered – promotions to occur in October (away from the pressures of the end of the season – would have had 10 rounds of pairs – definitely do'able).

To consider not allowing those who are effectively "Silver Players playing in Silver Reserve" to be allowed to play with Silver players in mixed competitions.

To ensure that the handicaps applied to those who have declined promotion are not advantaging them when they play in club handicapped tournaments.

To encourage ideas to come forward from the club for consideration.

All these matters to be raised at the April meeting.
