Holiday Bridge

Tournament Ratings 2021

NZ Bridge have decided on a change of Open tournament ratings for 2021.

Open players will only be Provincial Masters ie 50 A Points and above. This change means all Local Masters, those with less than 50 A Points, will now be back to Intermediate status. This change affects about 14 club members. The first tournament for 2021 at the club is 10A Otago/Southland Regional Swiss Pairs Saturday January 16th. Entries are already open at NZ Bridge or you can enter on the entry form in the foyer at the club. Great to see so many entries already from around the country.

Teams

Lists will be in the foyer early 2021 for Mixed Teams, Junior Teams, Championship Teams. We are looking at splitting the Championshp teams after the first round robin so the top teams play against each other as do the bottom teams. This will depend on numbers so the more the merrier in each team competition.

Programme changes:

Whitcombe & Tombs & Doris Hannan/Swiss Pairs

The intent of this series is to give everyone the opportunity to play with a different partner that they have not played with in a series prior to the event or subsequent to the event. In an attempt to make this series more favorable with our members we have decided the best place for this in our 2021 programme is at the end of the year. So to qualify to win this event you are required to play each of the 4 nights with a partner you have not previously played with during the year. This is run as a separate competition so does not affect any other trophies or promotion percentages so gives everyone the opportunity to play with 4 new partners. Also run as a stand-alone competition is the Regent & Pam Bower Swiss Pairs. We have moved this series to June to be followed by Avenal Park Swiss Pairs Tournament.

Silver Reserve Handicaps

After much discussion amongst the committee we have decided from 2021 to dispense with Handicaps to those players in Silver Reserve who meet promotion criteria but who choose to stay within the division. We have decided instead those members will no longer be eligible to win a series or any end of year trophies. This change only affects members who meet the promotion criteria and once the criteria is not met for two years this restriction will be lifted.

Thursday nights

Due to the success of the individual night in 2020 we have decided to run this event as a series with 3 individual nights in 2021. There are two cups for this event. Top Silver and top Silver Reserve player. So if you enjoyed this format, which seems like 44 members did, make sure you get your names down for the 2021 series. A great mix of divisions and you only need to play a board with each partner once each night.

We have also decided to run 2 Goulash nights on a Thursday which has proved very popular in the past. As previously requested by members we have several open nights on a Thursday where you can play with whoever you like. No partner required on these evenings as someone will be available to partner you if required. A great opportunity to practice any new bidding systems you may be developing with your partner.

Freemasons

We are fortunate to now share our building with the Freemasons as we also now share our expenses with them, which is a great saving to our budgets. 31 January 2021 we will be joining the Freemasons with an open day at the club. This may attract some potential new members who we hope will sign up for the next lot of lessons. This gives the public the opportunity to see first hand the inside of our club rooms.
