Bridge and Tournament News – January 2025

Bridge for 2024 is now over and members of our club have had some remarkable achievements for the year. Most of you will know we had 3 representatives in the Otago/Southland region team for the Interprovincial competition held last November in Wellington. Frances and her team won the Senior's section. Kerry and Blair were in the Intermediate team and they came second overall. These were great results.

Periodically, NZ Bridge publish the latest ranking reports. These cover all players in NZ affiliated to NZ Bridge so include Oamaru Bridge Club members. In the **final ranking reports for 2024** Oamaru featured twice. **Kerry Kelly** was 17th in the Local Master Division and **Blair Corlet** just missed out on being in the top 20 in the same division. Bronze player **Chrissy Joyce** made the 19th spot in the Novice division with 3.81 B points. Also notable, is that some of our newest players were not far off making the Novice list achieving just under this total. Well done all.

I have agreed to assist Liz this year with the Tournament Secretary duties. We are going to try and promote tournament play for anyone interested.

These can all be entered using the NZ Bridge site (note this is different from Bridge NZ). Anyone can access NZ Bridge, where there is so much information and items of interest. To enter a tournament, you need to Login using your email and password.

NZ Bridge/Tournaments/Upcoming tournaments/ Click on the event you wish to enter. Click the "Enter" box. Your name and NZ Bridge number will automatically populate the first box, enter your partners bridge number/name. Press ENTER. Both you and partner will receive an automatic email confirming your entry.

(If you are new to bridge first time users to the NZ Bridge site are required to input an access code. This is not their NZ Bridge player number. Our club Administrator for the site is Theo Jordens who will get

your unique number generated. You will then receive an email detailing the Access Code with instructions on how to register. If you are struggling with this step please contact me so I can help/direct you.)

Each tournament will have a flyer attached giving starting time, venue, type of tournament etc and whether lunch is provided or not. Also includes cost and sometimes the format for the tournament. Most clubs accept online payment so the bank account number will be listed. When you pay online, you will receive an email during the following days to say your entry has been marked as paid.
