Bridge Rules & Etiquette

In this new section to the newsletter we will look at some of the more common rule infringements and misunderstandings to try and help us all improve our knowledge of the game we play.

Law 16B – Extraneous Information from Partner

We have all seen it at the bridge table, the unmistakable hesitation, unnecessary speed, special emphasis, tone, gesture, movement or mannerism. If your partner is guilty of anyone of these, be very careful what you bid next. If you (as the partner) were always going to bid 4H, and could justify that bid to the Director, then that is fine. However if you infer anything from partners actions, and bid on that basis, then you can be penalised.

Of course, sometimes we do need to think about things a little bit longer. In this instance please make an effort to sit calmly, keep a poker face, and keep your pencil still until you are ready to write.
