Announcing of 1C and Natural 1NT opening Bids.

The official bulletin for this new 'rule' is attached to this email, you can also find this pinned to our notice board.

Due to the number of variations of meaning that can exist with the 1C and 1NT opening bids, Bridge New Zealand have determined that the meaning of such bids must now be promptly announced by opener's partner. This has been done in England and the US for some time and is widely accepted as the best method in this instance.

Should your opponents fail to announce, please feel free to remind them before making your bid.
